

## DIRECTIONS TO LOCH INSH OUTDOOR CENTRE

Travel time -

By Car from Edinburgh or Glasgow - approx 2 ½ hrs

By Train - regularly from Edinburgh, Glasgow, Inverness and Perth, stopping at Aviemore and Kingussie - approx 3 hrs; good Taxi services from both towns

By Air - daily flights to and from Inverness to London etc; Car Hire available at airport; taxi and bus connections to Inverness then train to Aviemore.

**Driving South from Inverness:- approx 1 hr**

- Turn off A9 at South exit (2<sup>nd</sup>) for Aviemore;
- Take the B1952 for Kinraig - follow the Brown/Thistle signs for "Loch Insh Watersports Centre"  
- 6 miles south of Aviemore is the village of Kinraig.
- Turn left following the Brown/Thistle signs for "Loch Insh Watersports Centre"  
- drive through the village and after approx 1 mile you will see Loch Insh, our Sailing and Activity centre and the Boathouse Restaurant.
- For Chalet and B&B accommodation, continue up the hill to the T-junction
- Turn right and after 100m turn right at the Bed & Breakfast sign
  - Reception and Office are straight ahead; parking is on the left side of the office.

**Driving North from Edinburgh/Glasgow via Perth:- approx 2½ hrs**

- Turn off A9 at exit for Newtonmore or Kingussie;
- Take the B1952 for Kinraig - follow the Brown/Thistle signs for "Loch Insh Watersports Centre"  
- 6 miles north of Kingussie is the village of Kinraig.
- Turn right following the Brown/Thistle signs for "Loch Insh Watersports Centre"  
- drive through the village and after approx 1 mile you will see Loch Insh, our Sailing and Activity centre and the Boathouse Restaurant.
- For Chalet and B&B accommodation, continue up the hill to the T-junction
- Turn right and after 100m turn right at the Bed & Breakfast sign
  - Reception and Office are straight ahead; parking is on the left side of the office.

**Driving East from Fort William:- approx 1½ hrs**

- At Newtonmore follow the signs for Kingussie/Inverness;
- Take the B1952 to Kinraig - follow the Brown-Thistle signs for "Loch Insh Watersports Centre"  
- 6 miles north of Kingussie is the village of Kinraig.
- Turn right following the Brown-Thistle signs for "Loch Insh Watersports Centre"  
- drive through the village and after approx 1 mile you will see Loch Insh, our Sailing and Activity centre and the Boathouse Restaurant.
- For Chalet and B&B accommodation, continue up the hill to the T-junction
